1.You will need to submit a Log of Professional Development Activities, along with <u>the supporting documentation</u> to show completion of the activities listed on the log. Here is the link to obtain the Log of Professional Development Activities form: http://www.orepdc.k12.or.us/pdf/PDUlog.pdf

2.Educators are required to: (1) track completed PDUs and enter them on a log; and (2) ensure that activities must fall within one of the seven "standards" specified in OAR 584-090-0110 in order to earn credit. These professional development opportunities do not differ from PDUs that were required if or when you were a full-time employed educator. 3. <u>Supporting documentation</u> would be some type of proof that you completed the activities listed on the Log of

Professional Development Activities. For example; Certificate of Completion, Certificate of Attendance, Official

Transcript (unopened), official letter/email, etc. These items need to show your name, the name of the activity, the date of the activity, the number of PDUs, credits earned or time to complete (minutes and/or hours). You can also submit a Verification of Attendance at Event to Earn Professional Development Units (PDUs). Here's the link for this
